### Great Aussie Bush Camp



## FINDING EAGLES

Building Strength and Hope



A group program for families who have experienced complex trauma. Parents/carers and their child attend together. Children must be in Year's 3 to 6 at Primary School.

Finding Eagles involves 5 afternoon sessions with you and your child where you'll learn together how the brain and emotions work and what skills can help each of you with those big emotions and make better choices.
